01: EVENT STYLE

Pre entry only, Limited number event, Adjoining classes entry only.

02: CLASSES

Class 2: Jingle Bell Rocks, 50cm**

Class 3: Santa Claus is coming to town, 60cm**

Class 4: Wish it could be Christmas, 70cm

Class 5: Last Christmas, 80cm

Class 6: Fairytale of New York, 90cm

03: RESTRICTIONS

04: SHOWJUMPING COURSE.

Built with BSJA standard in mind and Showjumping phase to be ran under British Showjumping rules, timed accordingly as well as competitor dress / Horse Tack.

Two Phase style

First round, those jumping clear, continue directly onto the 2nd phase. without interruption.

Other competitors placed according to their Penalties and time.

Jump off, against the clock, competitors placed on faults and time.

The course will remain the same throughout the day event.

05: WARM UP.

Opens at 09:00am, please ensure that the fence is kept at the height of the class.

06: COURSE WALK

A course walk will be available at the start of each class, the course will remain the same throughout the day.

07: COMPETITORS NUMBER

Competitors will be allocated a number from the event secretary, please ensure this is visible.

08: DRESS CODE

Christmas Jumpers, Show Jacket and correctly fitted riding Helmet / Boots must be worn
Body Protectors are advised for juniors, and we do not encourage Juniors to wear spurs within smaller classes.

09: CAR PARKING

We encourage shared transport, hacking to the centre due to the car parking being limited to the main event carpark, Car park 1.

Please state within the additional comments your friends name / Vehicle Reg number, this will allow us to open an additional space.

Lane Farm Livery's, please note in additional comments that you are stabled at the yard, the adjoining classes rule does not apply to yourselves.

17. ADDITIONAL REQUESTS:

Additional requests must be submitted in writing prior on entry , any on the day request will need to be submitted to the event sectary, additional charges may be requested.

18. BBDRRC RULES:

Please ensure that you read and understand the below terms and conditions.

- Competitors under the age of 18 must have parents' permission and supervised by a responsible adult during this event.
- Emergency contact details must be updated / provided on booking.

- BBDRC and Venue will accept no responsibility for any injuries or damage caused to or by any person, horse or vehicle
- Riders ride at their own risk
- It is recommended that all competitors have their own public liability insurance
- Any behaviour deemed inappropriate will result in removal from the grounds of the event
- Anyone mounted MUST be wearing a correctly fitted riding helmet.
- No horse or pony under the age of 4 to be entered.
- Annual Equine Flu Vaccinations must be up to date. Any animal thought to be suffering from any infectious disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately by a member of the committee. No refund to be provided.
- Dogs must be controlled at all times
- Please pick up any litter and have respect for venue
- The Judge's decision is FINAL
- Complaints / Objections must be submitted in writing within 30 minutes of the dispute. A £40 deposit must be paid. Which will be returned to the competitor if objection is upheld. The decision of the investigating officer / Committee is FINAL.
- The committee present at the event will deal with all disputes relating to Club activities and their decision being final and binding without any appeal to law.

- Time slots allocated prior the event. We ask that you arrive in good time for warm up only and once you have finish competing to return to your vehicle and required to leave the show ground.
- Please no haynets to be tied up to the side for your transport.
- Please do not skip/muck out your trailer whilst on the showground

- Please ask a Stewart if you're stuck.
